Program Notes

The Marian Antiphons, *Alma Redemptoris Mater*, *Ave Regina Caelorum*, *Regina Caeli*, and *Salve Regina*, have concluded the sung office of Compline, or night prayer, for centuries. These beautiful prayers to the Blessed Virgin Mary may also be used on Marian feast days and other liturgies during the appropriate liturgical season. *Alma Redemptoris Mater* is specifically used from the first Sunday of Advent until the feast of the Presentation of the Lord on February 2.

Written in January 2021 in Oklahoma City, this setting is based on the simple Mode V chant tone. The chant melody can be heard migrating through each part of the choral texture. The combination of traditional organum and contemporary harmonies creates a fresh sound.
