Notes:

The Cello II part largely doubles the Cello I, except towards the latter half of the piece. In general, when parts can be performed double stop, that is the best method. Divisi may be used when necessary but is not ideal.

Program Notes:

A "Phantom", while often understood as a ghost or spirit, refers to a general sense of illusion or figment of our imagination. This work explores elements of dream, subconsciousness, and the supernatural with the contrasting sections of heavy brooding melody, ethereal chord progression, and twinkle of the celesta. While an original composition, the concept derived from various inspirations such as the music of Bartok, Stravinsky, and Brahms - a combination that provided a useful combination of sounds and musical devices appropriate for the subject.
