## Program Notes

Good music played well inspires the imagination. *At Six We Ate* was written as an easy approach for youngsters to learn the basic rhythms of 6/8 time. The title is a pun – get it? Opening dotted half notes, expand into dotted quarters, then the bouncing quarter/8<sup>th</sup> pattern, and finally into straight 8<sup>th</sup> notes in a triple pattern. The use of rests and long tones across several bars(rests on beat 1) were thought out to challenge your student to count rests and long tones in a way that takes them out of their comfort zone. To add to the fun, with the dinner reference in the title, the dark and brooding nature of *At Six We Ate* seems to imply *indigestion!*
