## PROGRAM NOTES

**Where The Wild Things Dance** was written to celebrate the Sandhill Cranes of Monte Vista, Colorado. The Sandhill Crane puts on an elaborate courtship ritual to attract a mate. As part of this ritual, the cranes bow, flap their wings, leap and twirl in the air like rhythmic gymnasts. This work was written to embody the spirited movements created by the cranes during this timeless ritual.

**Where The Wild Things Dance** was selected as the Winner of the 2018 Thornton Community Band Composition Contest (Thornton, Colorado) in commemoration of their 10th anniversary.

## NOTES TO CONDUCTOR

The duration is three minutes at the marked tempo. Careful attention to articulations, dynamic changes and phrasing should be given throughout the work.

Though the work has many syncopated patterns, a lot of repetition occurs passing the patterns to various sections throughout the ensemble. Some patterns can be rehearsed by utilizing different sections at the same time. (ex. Brass at measure 21 with Piccolo, Flute, Oboe, Clarinets and Alto Sax at measure 79.)

Detailed attention should be given to the percussion throughout as these parts are supportive and then soloistic at times.

Ensure the repeated staccato patterns aren't played too heavily. (ex. measure 64)

**Joseph Benjamin Earp** is Director of Athletic Bands at Limestone College in Gaffney, South Carolina. He received his undergraduate degree in Music Education from the University of North Carolina at Charlotte and his Master of Music in Music Education from Anderson University in Anderson, South Carolina. His professional teaching career began at Seneca High School in South Carolina as Director of Bands in 2006. After two years, he then taught at Robbinsville Middle and High Schools for a year before becoming the founding Director of Bands at Cox Mill High School in Concord, North Carolina. In addition to teaching, Mr. Earp is an active published composer and clinician with his music being performed internationally.
